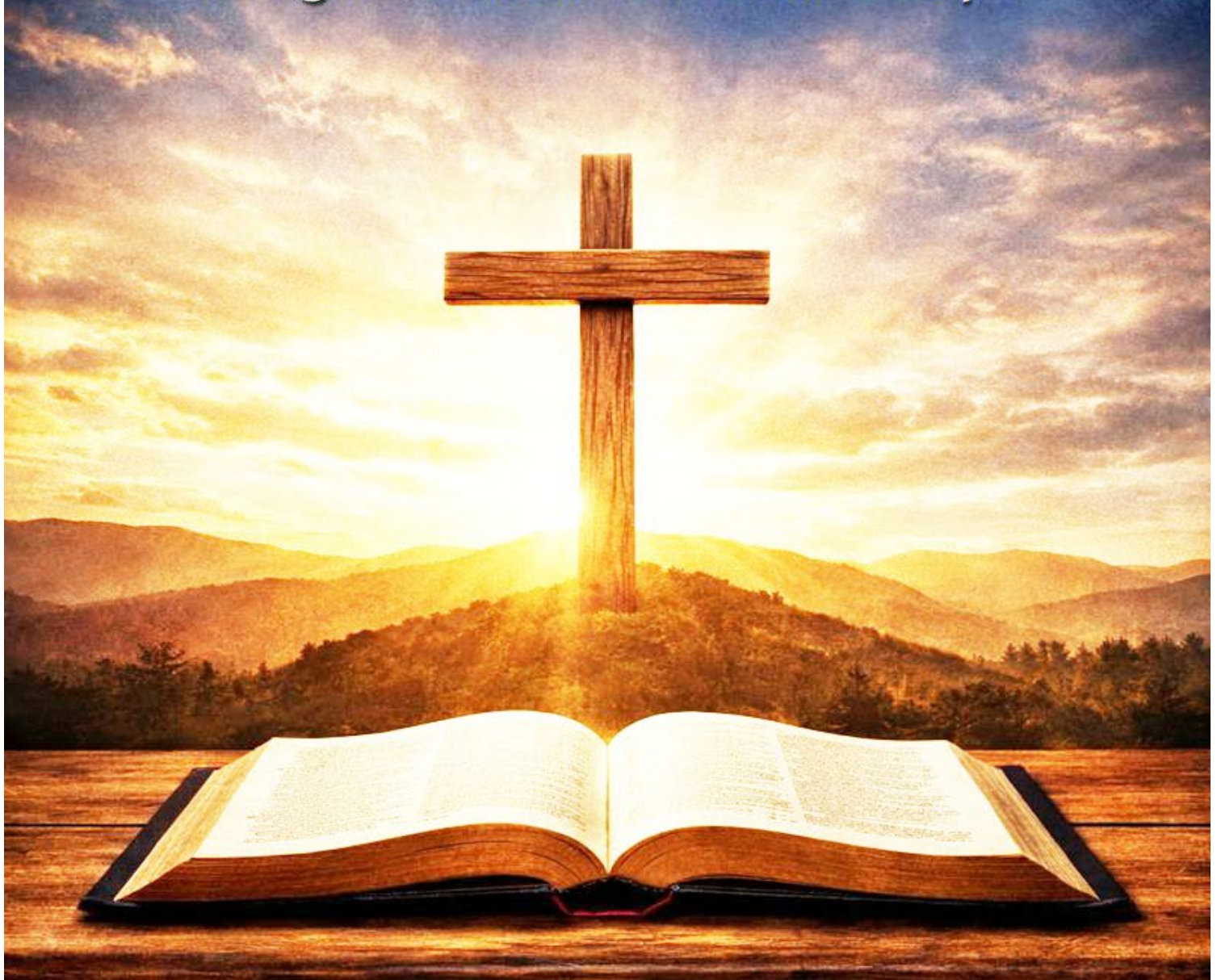

Learning Centers Begin In Willing Hearts

INTRODUCTION

This guide exists to help willing believers learn who Jesus is, follow Him, grow in confidence, and help others follow Him also.

You do not need to be a pastor, teacher, or missionary to begin helping others follow Christ. Any believer with a willing heart can learn, grow, and share biblical truth with others and then become a discipler who helps disciple others.

It is designed to help you:

learn truth from God's Word,

place that truth into your permanent

memory,

live it out in everyday life,

and share it naturally with others.

The LORD delights in using willing hearts.

Many believers sincerely want to serve Christ but have never been shown a simple pathway for learning, remembering, and sharing biblical truth. This Learning Center is designed to help provide that pathway.

True learning is not simply hearing truth.

True learning is when truth becomes part of your life and begins flowing through you to others.

Everything in this guide begins with one foundation:

JESUS FIRST.

Before learning commandments, doctrine, or

Christian living, you must first know who Jesus is.

HOW THIS GUIDE WORKS

Each Learning Center session follows four simple steps:

1. Learn

Understand truth clearly from God's Word.

2. Recall

Repeat truth until it becomes part of your permanent memory.

3. Share

Explain the truth to another person in your own words.

4. Sow

Use what you have learned to encourage,

witness to, and help disciple others.

Learning is not complete until truth begins helping others learn and follow Christ.

This is how willing believers begin participating in fulfilling the Great Commission.

SECTION 1

JESUS FIRST

Question 1

Who is the Jesus of the Bible?

Answer

He is the eternal Son of God.

Question 2

Why do we believe that Jesus is God?

Answer

Because the Bible calls Him God.

Supporting Scriptures

John 1:1

Hebrews 7:3

John 20:28

1 Timothy 3:16

Revelation 1:8

LEARN

Jesus Christ did not begin in Bethlehem.

He is eternal.

He has no beginning and no end.

He is the Son of God, and He is God
manifested in the flesh.

He alone is worthy of your trust, obedience, worship, and lifelong devotion.

RECALL

Repeat both questions and answers until you can say them clearly without help.

Truth remembered becomes truth that shapes daily life.

SHARE

Explain to another person who Jesus is using the Scriptures.

Do not worry about speaking perfectly.

Simply share clearly what you have learned.

SOW

Tell at least one person this week who Jesus is according to the Bible.

The LORD can use willing hearts to help others know Christ.

SECTION 2

TRINITY SECOND

What is the Trinity?

The Trinity is a word used to describe the eternal relationship within the Godhead—God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.

God is one eternal being in three eternal Persons.

Each Person is fully God.

There is only one God.

Supporting Scriptures

John 6:27

John 1:1

Acts 5:3–4

1 Timothy 2:5

LEARN

God is one, yet He reveals Himself as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

The Father is God.

The Son is God.

The Holy Spirit is God.

Yet there is only one God.

RECALL

Repeat these truths until they become part of your permanent memory:

God is one

God is three Persons

Each Person is God

Truth remembered builds confidence and understanding.

SHARE

Explain the Trinity to another person using Scripture.

Help them understand what the Bible says about God.

SOW

Teach one person this week that the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are all called God in Scripture.

SECTION 3

HOLY SPIRIT THIRD

What is the role of the Holy Spirit in the life of a believer?

The Holy Spirit gives new birth to those who repent and believe.

He enables believers to overcome.

He gives assurance that you belong to God.

He guides believers into truth.

Supporting Scriptures

John 3:5

1 John 4:4

Romans 8:16

John 16:13

LEARN

The Holy Spirit lives in every believer.

He gives life, strength, assurance, comfort, guidance, and spiritual understanding.

The Christian life was never meant to be lived alone.

The Holy Spirit helps believers follow Christ daily.

RECALL

Repeat this truth until it becomes part of your memory:

“Greater is He that is in me, than he that is in the world.”

1 John 4:4

SHARE

Explain to another believer how the Holy Spirit helps you live for Christ.

Encourage them from Scripture.

SOW

Encourage one person this week using 1 John 4:4.

The LORD often uses simple encouragement to strengthen willing hearts.

REVIEW

Make sure you can clearly explain:

Who Jesus is

Why Jesus is God

What the Trinity is

What the Holy Spirit does

If you can explain these truths clearly from Scripture, confidence is growing.

As confidence grows, believers become better equipped to help others learn and follow Christ.

LIVING AS A DISCIPLE

2 Timothy 2:2

Discipleship is not complete until truth is passed on to others.

The Great Commission belongs to every believer.

Ask yourself:

Who am I learning from?

Who am I encouraging?

Who could I help this week?

Who may need these truths next?

Learning Centers begin with willing hearts that are ready to grow and help others grow also.

COMMITMENT

Commitment to Follow Christ and Help Others Follow Him

Having learned who Jesus is—the eternal Son of God—and having committed these truths to memory, I recognize Christ’s call not only to follow Him, but also to help others follow Him.

Who Jesus is

That God is one in three Persons—Father,
Son, and Holy Spirit

That the Holy Spirit lives within believers
and guides them into truth

Scripture

To encourage others in their walk with Christ

To trust the LORD to use my willing heart
