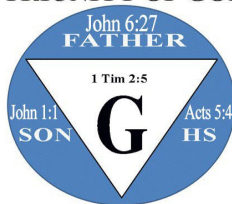
Trinity: Three Examples

1. A word used to speak of the eternal relationship of the Members of the Godhead—God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.

2. It is the belief that God is one eternal being in three eternal persons.

3. In the Godhead, there are three Persons. Each Person is fully God. There is only one God.

Scripture Supports These Truths

The Father is called God (John 6:27) Labour not for the meat which perisheth, but for that meat which endureth unto everlasting life, which the Son of man shall give unto you: for him hath God the Father sealed.

Jesus is called God (John 1:1) In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word [title for Jesus] was God.

The Holy Spirit is called God (Acts 5:3-4)3 But Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost, and to keep back part of the price of the land? ... why hast thou conceived this thing in thine heart? Thou hast not lied unto men, but unto God.

1Tim 2:5 For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;

JESUS FIRST IS WHERE WE BEGIN

As teachers guide and learners engage, truth moves from instruction to memory, from memory to obedience, and from obedience to making disciples who can teach others also.

Purpose

This Learning Center exists to help you know who Jesus is, follow Him faithfully, learn the truth, commit it to memory, live it out, and share it with others.

Everything begins with Jesus First. Before learning commandments, doctrine, or Christian living.

Each Learning Session will ask you to do four things:

1. Learn the truth from God's Word

Who Is the Jesus of the Bible?

Key Scriptures:

John 1:1; Hebrews 7:3; Isaiah 9:6

Jesus Christ did not begin in Bethlehem. He is the eternal Son of God. He has no beginning and no end. He is God manifested in the flesh and worthy of your trust, obedience, and worship.

Learn and Remember:

- Jesus is eternal
- Jesus is God
- Jesus does not change
