

INTRODUCTION

This Learning Center exists to help you learn who Jesus is, follow Him, and become a disciple who helps others follow Him.

This guide is not for reading only. It is designed to help you learn the truth from God's Word, place that truth into your memory, live it out in your life, and share it with others.

True learning is not just hearing truth. True learning is when truth becomes part of you

and flows through you to others.

Everything in this guide begins with one foundation:

Jesus First.

Before learning commandments, doctrine, or Christian living, you must know who Jesus is.

HOW THIS GUIDE WORKS

Each Learning Center session follows four simple steps:

1. Learn

Understand the truth from God's Word.

2. Recite

Repeat the truth until it is in your memory.

3. Share

Explain the truth to another person.

4. Sow

Use the truth in witnessing and discipling others.

Learning is complete when you can teach what you have learned.

SECTION 1

JESUS FIRST

Question 1

Who is the Jesus of the Bible?

Answer

He is the eternal Son of God.

Question 2

Why do we believe that Jesus is God?

Answer

Because the Bible calls Him God.

Supporting Scriptures

John 1:1

Hebrews 7:3

John 20:28

1 Timothy 3:16

Revelation 1:8

Learn

Jesus Christ did not begin in Bethlehem.

He is eternal. He has no beginning and no end. He is the Son of God, and He is God manifested in the flesh.

He is worthy of your trust, your obedience, and your worship.

Recite

Repeat both questions and answers until you can say them without help.

Share

Explain to another person who Jesus is using

the Scriptures.

Sow

Tell at least one person this week who Jesus is from the Bible.

SECTION 2

TRINITY SECOND

What is the Trinity?

The Trinity is a word used to describe the eternal relationship of the Godhead—God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.

God is one eternal being in three eternal persons.

Each Person is fully God. There is only one God.

Supporting Scriptures

John 6:27

John 1:1

Acts 5:3–4

1 Timothy 2:5

Learn

God is one, but He is revealed in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

Recite

Repeat these truths until they are in your memory:

- God is one
- God is three persons
- Each Person is God

Share

Explain the Trinity to another person using Scripture.

Sow

Teach one person that the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are all called God.

SECTION 3

HOLY SPIRIT THIRD

What is the role of the Holy Spirit in the life of a believer?

He gives new birth to those who repent and believe

He enables believers to overcome

He gives assurance that you are a child of God

He guides you into truth

Supporting Scriptures

John 3:5

1 John 4:4

Romans 8:16

John 16:13

Learn

The Holy Spirit lives in every believer.

He gives you life, strength, assurance, and guidance.

Recite

Repeat this truth:

“Greater is He that is in me than he that is in the world.”

Share

Explain to another believer how the Holy Spirit helps you live for Christ.

Sow

Encourage one person this week using 1 John 4:4.

REVIEW

Make sure you can clearly explain:

- Who Jesus is
- Why Jesus is God
- What the Trinity is
- What the Holy Spirit does

If you can teach these truths, you are ready to begin discipling others.

LIVING AS A DISCIPLE

2 Timothy 2:2

Discipleship is not complete until truth is passed on to others.

Ask yourself:

- Who am I learning from?
- Who am I teaching now?
- Who will I teach next?

COMMITMENT

Commitment to Follow Jesus and Make Disciples

Having learned who Jesus is—the eternal Son of God—and having committed these truths to memory, I recognize His call not only to follow Him, but to make disciples.

I now understand:

- Who Jesus is
- That God is one in three persons—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit
- That the Holy Spirit lives in me and will guide me

With God's help, I commit:

- To follow Jesus Christ in obedience
- To keep these truths in my memory
- To share them with others from Scripture
- To teach others so they may also become disciples

I understand that discipleship is not complete until the truth is passed on.

By God's grace, I will live as a disciple who makes disciples.
